## You can live here!

Located in southwest Detroit, Chadsey-Condon, including Claytown is a very multicultural neighborhood. An active community, neighbors along with local organizations including Bridging Communities and the Chadsey-Condon Community Organization host several family activities and clean-up initiatives throughout the year.

### HOMES

Chadsey-Condon housing stock varies with a selection of Tudors, colonials, single-family and multi-family brick homes.

### SHOPPING

As a multicultural neighborhood, Chadsey-Condon has many full-line grocery stores carrying multi-ethnic products. It is also home to over 30 multi-ethnic restaurants ranging from Middle-Eastern to Salvadoran cuisine.

### SCHOOLS

This neighborhood is home to more than 15 schools including the recently constructed Munger Elementary-Middle School.



### HEALTH

Chadsey-Condon has over 15 health facilities that provide internal medicine, pediatrics, women's health, dentistry, mental health, and senior services and more.



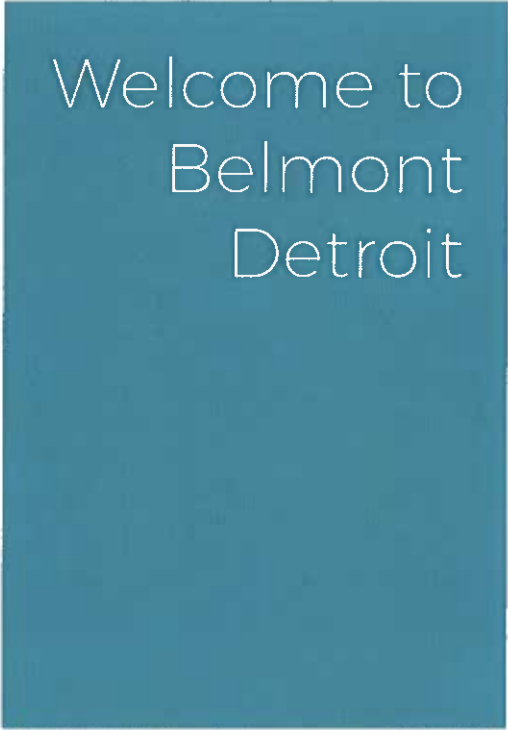
### COMMUNITY

### LOCATION

Located on the northern end of Southwest Detroit with Wyoming to the west bordering Dearborn, I-96 to the east, West Warren to the north and John Kronk to the south. Chadsey-Condon is only five minutes from downtown Detroit and minutes away from I-96, I-75, the Lodge, and Southfield freeway.

Located on the northwest side of Detroit, Belmont is a community of friendly neighbors that love to maintain their homes.

This neighborhood has active block clubs that meet on a monthly basis. It is surrounded by churches and is not far from fun, free, family activities at the Northwest Activities Center.



### HOMES

The typical Belmont home is a single-family colonial brick house. This neighborhood also includes a few brick bungalows.

### SHOPPING

This neighborhood has 3 full-line grocery stores and is close to retail

shopping and restaurants on Greenfield Road.



### SCHOOLS

Belmont is home to the Coleman A. Young Elementary School and close to 7 other Detroit Public Schools including the King John R. Academic and Performing Arts Academy. Nearby is the Loyola Jesuit Catholic High School. Belmont is also minutes away from the University of Detroit Mercy and Marygrove College.

### HEALTH

Belmont is close to the DMC Sinai Grace Hospital, Henry Ford Medical Center-Detroit Northwest.



### RECREATION

There are many recreational activities to do at the Northwest Activities Center including swimming, basketball, dance classes, aerobics, and more. Activities are designed for youth, families, and seniors. Belmont is also close to 3 Detroit area golf courses: Rouge Park Golf Course, Palmer Park Golf Course, and the Detroit Golf Club.



### LOCATION

Located on the northwest side of Detroit with Puritan to the north, Greenfield Road to the west, Fenkell to the south and Strathmoor to the east. Belmont is nestled in the middle of the Southfield, the John C. Lodge and I-96 freeways and is only 15 minutes from downtown Detroit.



# Welcome to Warrendale Detroit

## You can live here!

Warrendale is a multi-cultural neighborhood located on the far west side of Detroit just north of Dearborn. This growing community has an active safety patrol and is close to the Buffalo Soldiers Heritage Center.

### HOMES

Typical housing in Warrendale consist of ranches, bungalows (brick and aluminum), duplexes and colonials.

### SHOPPING

This neighborhood is close to full-line grocery stores that carry multi-ethnic products and near retail stores and restaurants on Ford Road and the Fairlane Shopping Center.

### SCHOOLS

Warrendale is home to two elementary schools, and is near Henry Ford College and the University of Michigan-Dearborn.



### HEALTH

Warrendale has 11 health facilities in the area including the iAmerica Medical Behavioral & Mental Health facility. It is also minutes away from several other health facilities including the Henry Ford Fairlane Medical Center.



### GREEN SPACES

Living in Warrendale gives you plenty of access to green spaces including Ryan, Rouge and Hines Parks. Hike, walk, or bike in Rouge Park, the nation's largest urban park. There are also four bioretention flower gardens constructed on vacant lots to help manage storm water.



### LOCATION

Located on the far west side of Detroit, with Joy Road to the north, bordering Dearborn along Ford Road to the south, Southfield Freeway to the east, and Rouge Park to the west. Warrendale is close to both I-94 and I-96.
