PLASTIC

NOTE: it is easier to keep your #1 separate from your #4-#7 like we do here at the drop off. Saves you a sorting step!

We can accept plastics #1, #2, #4, #5, #6, #7. We cannot accept #3, ABS or PVC. To assure that an item is recyclable it must be labeled with a recycling number from the manufacturer. This is typically found underneath or on the bottom of a container inside a "Recycling triangle"

METAL

All containers, all types. Large scrap items will be subject to the discretion of our staff.

GLASS

All containers, NO window glass, treated glass, or Pyrex.

NOTE: we separate color glass and clear glass.

PAPER

NOTE: our specific paper sorting categories are OFFICE PAPER, GLOSSY PAPER, NEWSPAPER, BOOKS (bound), and SHREDDED PAPER. All loose leaf, magazines, newspaper, mailers, envelopes, posters, flyers. NO tissue paper or wax paper. All shredded should arrive bagged separately.

CARDBOARD

NOTE: Some boxes, even when flat must be cut down to fit properly fit in our compactor.

Boxes are easy to identify, but be sure that the inside is in fact a brown paper material. Cardboard must be broken down, flattened and easy to handle.

STYROFOAM

STYROFOAM: take out containers, and packing material. All items must be clean and of a proper consistency of polystyrene.

These items CANNOT be accepted currently:

X Plastic bags, X Aseptic, X Electronics, X Batteries, X Lightbulbs, X Ink Cartridges

ALL MATERIAL MUST BE CLEAN, CONTAINERS EMPTY,
BOXES FLATTENED
