## You CAN register and vote:

- ✓ Misdemeanors and felonies on your record.
- ✓ Incarcerated pretrial or waiting to be sentenced.
- ✓ Without a photo ID.
- ✓ On probation or parole.

## How to register and vote:

**Online (Michigan ID required) or by mail (absentee):**  
[www.michigan.gov/vote](http://www.michigan.gov/vote).

### **In Person:**

Visit your city or township clerk's office and provide proof of residency any time up to 8:00pm on election day - Tuesday, November 8th.

## You can vote early!
