

VOTING INFORMATION

You CAN register and vote:



(1) Incarcerated pretrial or waiting to be sentenced.

Without a photo ID.

On probation or parole.

How to register and vote:

Online (Michigan ID required) or by mail (absentee): www.michigan.gov/vote.

In Person:

Visit your city or township clerk's office and provide proof of residency any time up to 8:00pm on election day - Tuesday, November 8th.

You can vote early!

You don't need to wait until election day to vote. Get started today! Visit www.michigan.gov/vote and select "Early voting."
