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Description: Big “D” landscaping was hired to restore and beautify a residential area with more than 5 units which could result in possible fugitive dust during the work. This work will involve re-grading the lawn in front and behind the structure, removing the top layer of grass and weeds. Then distributing a layer of topsoil about 4” in depth with addition of grass seed. Shrubs and plants will be added.

Duration: 2 months.

Fugitive dust control measures:

The soil will be dropped by a dump truck at property and then distributed. The soil will be damp when it arrives and will be moved promptly. If there are high wind conditions, an employee will wet it the pile down. If it rains and track out occurs, Big “D” has allowed enough in the budget to hire a wet vacuum truck to clean the roads surrounding the property. **No blowers will be used to prevent fugitive dust.**

Track-out – Mud will be sprayed off the truck tires by employees on site prior to leaving the site. If needed the company will hire a street sweeping company to clean mud that was tracked out of the site and into the neighborhood.
