## PROPOSAL SUMMARY

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded the City of Detroit \$57.6 million under HUD's Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery program (CDBG-DR). This award is specifically for aiding Detroit in recovering from the June, 2021 presidentially-declared disaster, and mitigating risk and impact of future disasters. The City of Detroit is seeking community input on a Draft Action Plan that lays out potential eligible activities that the CDBG-DR award could fund.
